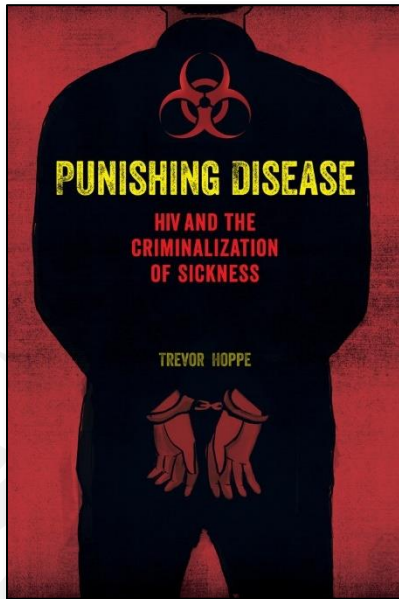


# BOOK LAUNCH & PANEL DISCUSSION

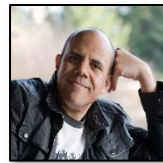
