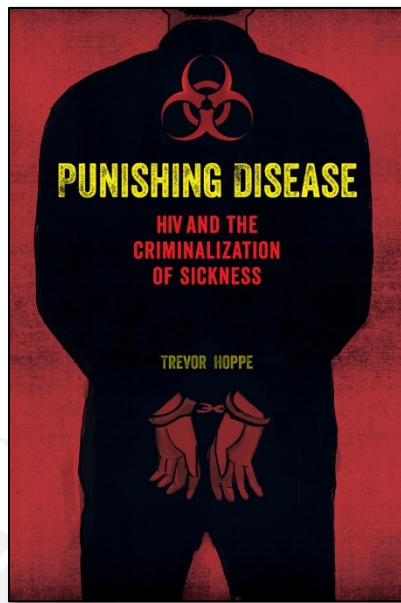


BOOK LAUNCH & PANEL DISCUSSION
